2022 License Renewal is Less Than 100 Days Away!

2022 is a license renewal year! Requirements **MUST** be completed by August 31, 2022– less than 100 days away!

Each renewal period requires **24 CEUs** – which must include 2 CEUs of Act31 (3CEUs are required if this is your first renewal period!). Mandated Child Abuse Reporter Training (PA Act31) is only available online. PCA has an Act31 Webinar scheduled for July 9, 2022.

Reporting to the State is **YOUR** responsibility! You must maintain and keep track of your acquired credits and submit to the State when you renew. The PCA does not maintain a record of your CEUs. Certificates for CEUs obtained through PCA Events are sent via email to the registrants email within 2 weeks of the event- make sure to check your spam folder! If you earned CE at the 2022 Annual Convention your certificates are available in your Results@Hand profile.
